The first paragraph must contain the author's name and the book title. The first paragraph must also mention the theme of the book. The theme of a story is the 'big idea' or its underlying message; this belief is universal, meaning that everyone throughout the world and even time can relate to it. You would also want to include any other interesting facts about the book here like if it won a prize or has historical significance.

The second paragraph is a BRIEF summary of the book. The summary should include information about the setting, the characters, and the plot. However, you must be careful to not go overboard on telling every little detail. You might want to construct a story mountain first and use that as your guide.

The third paragraph is where you can tell about your favorite part. Identify the part you liked the most and tell why. This a good place to use quotes from the book. We will learn how to properly cite quotes this year. This paragraph can discuss a favorite character or a favorite part of the plot. You can even discuss a favorite setting.

The fourth paragraph tells the reader how you feel about the book as a whole. Would you recommend the book to a friend? You will need to state your reasons with clarity.
