Components:

Project Board -

The project board must be able to stand (not just a poster). It must include: a title, 3 pictures (either drawn or from the internet) with captions, a complete explanation of your topic broken into subtopics - think about a five paragraph essay and your subtopics (300 - 500 words), and important dates (timeline).

Display-

You must make something related to your topic. You can build, knit, mold, paint, sew, bake, create... It must be neat and must relate directly to your topic. Creativity counts; please do not buy a kit and just assemble it. You should have some original work involved. Any important features should be labeled clearly.

Presentation-

You will present your project to the class; you will have two minutes. You cannot read from your board. You should have notecards or an outline to help you with your presentation.
